Overview

From September 2010 Schools and Colleges will have additional powers to search for drugs, alcohol, stolen goods, and prohibited items.

Legislation came into force in May 2007 and the Dcsf has issued guidance for schools and colleges.

Schools and Further Education Institutions already have the legal power to search without consent any pupil or student they reasonably suspect to have a knife or other offensive weapon.

This 5 hour course (excluding breaks) is for members of staff or persons in a school or an institution within the further education sector.

Who should attend?

Principals, Deputy / Assistant Head Teachers, Health and Safety Officers, School Security Coordinators, Teaching Staff, Premises Managers, Learning Support staff, Security Staff.

No previous knowledge or experience is required.
